The Bosphorus and Marmara are two iconic waterbodies in Turkey, attracting millions of tourists yearly. The Bosphorus is a strait. It separates Europe and Asia. It is the connecting link between the Black Sea to the Sea of Marmara. It has been a vital commercial and strategic waterway for centuries, and its shores are lined with historic landmarks and beautiful scenery. The Marmara Sea is a small inland sea known for its picturesque landscapes, historic sites, and vibrant culture. You will enjoy a two-hour boat trip across it. Its wooden houses and Ottoman villas allow visitors to experience the region's unique charm and rich history firsthand.
