

## 3Nights/4 Days

### Overview **Darjeeling**

Darjeeling, the "Queen of the Hills," is a popular tourist destination in northern West Bengal, India. Best known worldwide for its stunning panoramic views of the Himalayan mountain range, Kanchandzonga, and the entire Singalila Range. Journey through the hills, passing by scenic vistas, offering spectacular views of the mountains and eye-catching valleys in the Darjeeling Himalayan Railway ("Toy Train"), will be much appreciated. Darjeeling is also renowned for its tea gardens. Visitors can visit the tea gardens and learn about tea-making while enjoying a refreshing cup of tea. The town also boasts several religious and historical sites. Some are the Ghoom Monastery, the oldest monastery in Darjeeling, and the Japanese Peace Pagoda. Adventurous travellers can go trekking, mountaineering, and river rafting, for those who seek relaxation can indulge in spa and yoga retreats. If you want to experience natural beauty, rich culture, and warm hospitality, Darjeeling will be the best choice!

### Day 1 **Arrival**

Meet & Greet our guide on arrival at NJP Railway Station / IXB Airport & transfer to Darjeeling (6,950 ft.). Check into the hotel on arrival—the rest of the day at leisure. Overnight stay at Darjeeling.

### Day 2 **Darjeeling Sightseeing**

Early Morning (at 04:00 am), drive to Tiger hill (8,400 ft.) to watch the spectacular sunrise over the Himalayan range, which includes the third highest mountain in the world, Mt. Khangchendzongha. Tourists flock to this place every year to witness the breathtaking views that it has to offer. The sun's rays slowly paint the mountain range a golden hue, and as the sun rises, the whole range is bathed in warm sunlight, making it a sight to behold! On your way back, visit Ghoom Monastery. There you can see the 15-foot-high statue of the Maitreya Buddha and a collection of ancient manuscripts and artefacts of historical and religious significance. Then to Batasia Loop—an engineering marvel- a spiral track railway loop. After breakfast, visit the Himalayan Mountaineering Institute. Adventure enthusiasts will find this institution interesting. P.N. Zoological Park (Thursday closed) is home to various rare and endangered animals. Tenzing Rock which is about 50 feet high, offers a challenging climb. Tibetan Refugee self-help Centre (Sunday closed), Tea Garden (outer view), Ropeway, and Japanese Temple are other places to visit. Evening free for shopping or leisure. Overnight stay at Darjeeling.

### Day 3 **Mirik Excursion**

After breakfast, a full-day excursion trip to Mirik Lake (4,902 ft.) via Indo-Nepal Border (Extra vehicle charges will be applicable for Nepal Border to Pasupati Market). Mirik is famous for its man-made Sumendu Lake, Cardamom plantations and Tea Estates. The lake is surrounded by dense forests, lush green hills, and tea estates, making it one of the most scenic spots in the region. Visitors can go Boating on a direct payment basis in the lake. You can enjoy Boating, fishing, and picnicking at the lake. In the evening, return to the hotel. Overnight stay at Darjeeling.

### Day 4 **Departure**

After breakfast, Check-out from the hotel and take the departure transfers to NJP Railway Station / IXB Airport for your onward journey.
